Reimbursement to the department from General 14 15 Fund 16 In addition to the cost of search and rescue, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall be reimbursed annually from the General Fund, for fiscal year 1983 and thereafter, for 20% of the cost of ser-17 18 19 20 vices provided to other state agencies. These shall 21 be reasonable services which are necessary in assist-22 ing state agencies in carrying out their charge and 23 shall include assisting in the enforcement of land-24 use and environmental laws and regulations, animal 25 control, general law enforcement and other such areas 26 as shall be determined. To receive reimbursement, 27 documentation shall be submitted by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to the joint standing 28 29 committee having jurisdiction over appropriations and 30 financial affairs. Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is 31 appropriated 32 from the General Fund to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to reimburse the department 33 34 for expenditures made to perform search and rescue 35 activities during fiscal years 1960 to 1983 and for 36 20% of the expenditures made in fiscal year 1983 in 37 providing services to other state agencies.

There shall also be an annual cost to the General Fund hereafter as determined.
