HOUSE AMENDMENT "L" to H.P. 1769, L.D. 2336,  
8 Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Funding of the Depart-  
9 ment of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife."

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the  
11 emergency clause the following:

'PART R

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7002 is enacted to read:

14

§7002. Reimbursement to the department from General  
15 Fund

16

In addition to the cost of search and rescue, the  
17 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall be  
18 reimbursed annually from the General Fund, for fiscal  
19 year 1983 and thereafter, for 20% of the cost of ser-  
20 vices provided to other state agencies. These shall  
21 be reasonable services which are necessary in assist-  
22 ing state agencies in carrying out their charge and  
23 shall include assisting in the enforcement of land-  
24 use and environmental laws and regulations, animal  
25 control, general law enforcement and other such areas  
26 as shall be determined. To receive reimbursement,  
27 documentation shall be submitted by the Department of  
28 Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to the joint standing  
29 committee having jurisdiction over appropriations and  
30 financial affairs.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated  
32 from the General Fund to the Department of Inland  
33 Fisheries and Wildlife to reimburse the department  
34 for expenditures made to perform search and rescue  
35 activities during fiscal years 1960 to 1983 and for  
36 20% of the expenditures made in fiscal year 1983 in  
37 providing services to other state agencies.

5 Of this amount \$358,000 shall  
6 be for search and rescue and

10 Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts  
11 to read consecutively.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

13 This amendment provides for an appropriation of  
14 \$428,320 from the General Fund to the Department of  
15 Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for the reasonable  
16 costs of search and rescue incurred during fiscal  
17 years 1960 to 1983 and for expenditures made in fis-  
18 cal year 1983 in providing services to other state  
19 agencies. There shall also be an annual cost to the  
20 General Fund hereafter as determined.
