HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to H.P. 1772, L.D. 2340, Bill, "AN ACT To Authorize
a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of
\$15,735,000 to Plan, Construct and Equip Pollution
Abatement Facilities and to Abate, Clean Up and Miti-
gate Threats to Public Health and the Environment
from Uncontrolled Hazardous Substance Sites."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the
first paragraph after the title and inserting in its
place the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all
of the first sentence and inserting in its place the
following:

'The Treasurer of State may, under the direction of
the Governor, issue from time to time registered
bonds in the name and in behalf of the State to an
amount not exceeding \$15,735,000, of which \$3,235,000
may be issued on the effective date of this Act to
abate, clean up and mitigate threats to public health
and the environment from uncontrolled hazardous sub-
stance sites, as authorized by sections 6 and 7 and
of which \$12,500,000 may be issued after July 1,
1986, to provide funds to plan, construct and equip
pollution abatement facilities.'
