3 4 5	The total cost is estimated to be \$3,902,219. This amount includes interest calculated at 8.25% over 5 years.'
6	STATEMENT OF FACT
7 8 9 10 11	The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the amount of the bond issue to \$3,235,000, to clean up and mitigate threats to public health and the environment from uncontrolled hazardous substance sites. The amendment also reduces the life of the bond issue from 20 years to 5 years.
