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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1784, L.D. 2350,
Bill, "AN ACT to Allow State Party Committees to Es-
tablish the Time for Electing their Officers."

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Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting
clause the following:

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'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, party conventions are scheduled to be
held during the spring of the year; and

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Whereas, present law ties the time for election
of state party officers to the time of those conven-
tions; and

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Whereas, in order for this legislation to apply
to the upcoming election of party officers, it must
be enacted as emergency legislation; and

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Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore, '

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Further amend the Bill in that part designated
"§402." in subsection 3 in the 3rd line (page 2, line
17 in L.D.) by inserting before the word "prescribed"
the underlined word 'as'

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Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end
before the statement of fact the following:
