HOUSE AMENDMENT " $\widehat{A}$ " to H.P. 1776, L.D. .2354, "RESOLVE, to Establish a Select Committee Concerning Forest Practices in the State."

Amend the resolve after the emergency preamble by striking out the first paragraph (page 2, lines 7 to 20 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Select committee established. RESOLVED: select committee is established to study the forest practice actions occurring in the State. The committee shall consist of the following members: One member of the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources; one member of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife; one registered, professional forester from the University of Maine College of Forest Resources; one registered, professional forester from the Maine Forest Service; one registered forester representing the paper industry; one member representing small woodlot owners; and one member representing the public. The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate shall appoint the legislative committee members. The Governor shall appoint

Further amend the bill after the emergency preamble in the 2nd paragraph in the 4th line (page 2, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the words "clear cutting" and inserting in their place the following: 'forestry practices'

Further amend the bill in the last paragraph before the emergency clause in the 5th, 6th and 7th lines (page 2, lines 36 to 38 in L.D.) by striking out the punctuation and words ", except that the representative of the Bureau of Forestry shall not re-
