'Select committee established. RESOLVED: That a  
select committee is established to study the forest  
practice actions occurring in the State. The commit-  
tee shall consist of the following members: One mem-  
ber of the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and  
Natural Resources; one member of the Joint Standing  
Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife; one reg-  
istered, professional forester from the University of  
Maine College of Forest Resources; one registered,  
professional forester from the Maine Forest Service;  
one registered forester representing the paper indus-  
try; one member representing small woodlot owners;  
and one member representing the public. The Speaker  
of the House of Representatives and the President of  
the Senate shall appoint the legislative committee  
members. The Governor shall appoint the  
nonlegislative committee members.'
