"RESOLVE, to Establish a Select Committee Concerning

Forest Practices in the State."

Amend the resolve after the emergency preamble by

11

striking out the first paragraph (page 2, lines 7 to

12

20 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

13

'Select committee established. RESOLVED: That a

14

select committee is established to study the forest

15

practice actions occurring in the State. The commit-

16

tee shall consist of the following members: Three

17

members of the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and

18

Natural Resources; 3 members of the Joint Standing

19

Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife; one member

20

representing woodcutters; one member representing

21

the Paper Industry Information Office; one member

22

representing the University of Maine Department of

23

Forestry; one member representing the Maine Chapter

24

of the Society of American Foresters; and one member

25

of the Small Woodlot Owners Association of Maine.

26

The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the

27

President of the Senate shall appoint the legislative

28

committee members. The Governor shall appoint the

29

nonlegislative committee members in the following

30

manner: The members representing the Paper Industry

31

Information Office, the Maine Chapter of the Society

32

of American Foresters and the Small Woodlot Owners

33

Association of Maine shall be chosen from lists of 3

34

individuals submitted by the respective organiza-

35

tions; and the member representing woodcutters shall

36

be chosen by the Governor in such manner as the Gov-

37

ernor deems proper.'

Further amend the bill after the emergency pream-

ble in the 2nd paragraph in the 4th line (page 2,

line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the words "clear

7 resentative of the Bureau of Forestry shall not re-
8 ceive a per diem payment"
