The committee shall consist of the following members: Three members of the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources; 3 members of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife; one member representing woodcutters; one member representing the Paper Industry Information Office; one member representing the University of Maine Department of Forestry; one member representing the Maine Chapter of the Society of American Foresters; one member of the Small Woodlot Owners Association of Maine; and one member of the public. The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate shall appoint the legislative committee members. The committee shall also study the affects of forest practices on the fisheries and wildlife of the State and the impact of future trends in forest products markets on the state's forest resources.
