23 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves  
24 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90  
25 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;

27 Whereas, the Fair Harbor Residential Program is  
28 the only residential program in southern Maine avail-  
29 able to adolescent girls at risk who cannot be placed  
30 in a home setting, mental health facility or juvenile  
31 detention facility; and

32 Whereas, unless funds are immediately made avail-  
33 able, the program will have to be closed; and
