22 23 24	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
25 26	Whereas, primary elections will be held on June 12, 1984; and
27 28	Whereas, some municipalities wish to employ an outgoing voter check list in that election; and
29 30 31	Whereas, they will not be able to do so unless this provision is enacted as an emergency measure; and
32 33	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

- 1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
- 2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
- 3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
- 4 therefore,
- 5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 1. 21 MRSA §861, sub-§5, ¶A is enacted to 8 read:
- 9 A. If the municipality has required, by vote of
  10 municipal officials, the use of an outgoing check
  11 list, the voter shall announce his name and, upon
  12 request, street address to the election clerk in
  13 charge of that list prior to depositing the bal14 lots in the ballot box.
- 3. Appointment of wardens and ward clerks. At least 10 days before the election, the municipal officers of a city shall appoint a warden, ward clerk and at least 4 2 election clerks for each voting place created by the division. Election clerks must be nominated as provided in section 532.
- A. Exception. In a town, ward clerks are not appointed.
- Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

## 28 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this new draft is to allow municipalities to provide for use of an outgoing ballot clerk by vote of the municipal officers; and to add an emergency preamble and clause so that the provisions of this new draft will be in effect for this year's primary election.

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
