Allocations shall be issued on condition that the level and quality of service indicated by the prospectus shall be maintained by the outfitter during the term of the allocation. Substantial failure to maintain the level and quality of service may result in suspension, revocation or reduction in all or part of an allocation.

Reviews may be made, as provided by rule, within an allocation period or when a majority of the ownership of an outfitter is sold or otherwise transferred. Sale or transfer of majority ownership shall not be cause for reduction or revocation of an allocation without a showing that the sale or transfer creates a significant possibility of a failure to substantially maintain the level and quality of service.'
