SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 873, L.D. 2367,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Laws Concerning Commercial
Whitewater Rafting."

Amend the Bill in section 6 in subsection 7 in
the first paragraph in 3rd line (page 4, line 27 in
L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "they
satisfy" and inserting in their place the following:
'allocations provide a level and quality of service
which satisfies'

Further amend the Bill in section 6 in subsection
7 by adding at the end the following:

'D. Allocations shall be issued on condition
that the level and quality of service indicated
by the prospectus shall be maintained by the
outfitter during the term of the allocation.
Substantial failure to maintain the level and
quality of service may result in suspension, rev-
ocation or reduction in all or part of an alloca-
tion.

(1) The department may provide by rule for
review of an outfitter's provision of ser-
vice. Reviews may be made, as provided by
rule, within an allocation period or when a
majority of the ownership of an outfitter is
sold or otherwise transferred. Sale or
transfer of majority ownership shall not be
cause for reduction or revocation of an al-
location without a showing that the sale or
transfer creates a significant possibility
of a failure to substantially maintain the
level and quality of service.'


