If a milk dealer's refusal to continue to 13 purchase milk is based on failure of 14 the producer's milk to meet the milk dealer's quality 15 criteria or the Interstate Milk Shipments Confer-16 17 ence Standards, whichever is applicable, the refusal may become effective on less than 30 days' 18 19 Quality criteria established by the notice. dealer purchasing milk shall not be determined by 20 21 minimum levels for milk solids and milk fat set in section 2901, subsection 17. Upon issuance of 22 23 notice of intent to refuse purchase because of failure to meet the criteria or standards, the 24 dealer shall cause a sample of the refused milk 25 to be taken immediately and transferred to the commissioner for testing in the state central laboratory. Upon receipt of the test results 2б 27 28 29 that the sample does not meet the milk dealer's quality criteria or the Interstate Milk Shipments 30 31 Conference Standards, whichever is applicable, 32 refusal to continue to purchase shall become ef-33 fective immediately. Notice shall be given to 34 the producer by the dealer immediately upon his 35 receipt of the test results. The state central laboratory shall mail the results of the test to 36 37 the milk dealer and milk producer.

STATEMENT OF FACT

3 This amendment specifies that milk dealers cannot 4 justify a refusal to continue to purchase milk from 5 milk producers upon quality criteria which are deter-6 mined by minimum levels for milk solids and milk fat 7 established by Maine law.
