1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5	This amendment makes corrections in the compensation listed for the Board of Registration of Substance Abuse Counselors and the State Board of Assessment Review.
6 7 8	This amendment corrects the classification of the Animal Welfare Board from an advisory board to a policy-making board for specific or limited purposes.
9 10	The amendment changes the rate of per diem compensation for the State Parole Board.
11 12 13	The amendment also provides for an expenses-only rate of compensation for the State Court Library Committee.
14 15 16 17	Finally, the amendment adds a savings clause to the bill to make it clear that this bill will not affect the status of any board in existence prior to the enactment of this bill.
