SENATE AMENDMENT " C" to H.P. 1807, L.D. 2389,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Establish Standards and a Policy for
9 the Compensation of Members of Boards, Commissions
10 and Similar Organizations."

Amend the bill in section 39, in that part design-
12 nated "§12004." in subsection 1, paragraph A, subpar-
13 agraph (36) by striking out the underlined word
14 "None" and inserting in its place the underlined
15 words 'Not Authorized'

16

Further amend the bill in section 39, in that
17 part designated "§12004." in subsection 2, paragraph
18 A, subparagraph (1) by striking out the underlined
19 figure "\$100" and inserting in its place the under-
20 lined figure '\$50'

21

Further amend the bill in section 39, in that
22 part designated "§12004." in subsection 8, paragraph
23 A, by inserting before subparagraph (1) the follow-
24 ing:

25

'(1) Agriculture Animal \$35/Day 17 MRSA §1051-A
26 Welfare
27 Board'

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Further amend the bill in section 39, in that
29 part designated "§12004." in subsection 8, paragraph
30 A, subparagraph (1) (page 30, line 33 in L.D.) by
31 striking out the following: "\$25/Day" and inserting
32 in its place the following: 'Legislative Per Diem'

Further amend the bill in section 39, in that
34 part designated "§12004." in subsection 8, paragraph
35 A, subparagraph (15) (page 32, lines 12 and 13 in
36 L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "Not
37 Authorized" and inserting in their place the under-

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1 lined words 'Expenses only'

2 Further amend the bill in section 39, in that
3 part designated "§12004." in subsection 8, paragraph
4 A by renumbering the subparagraphs to read consecu-
5 tively.

6 Further amend the bill in section 39, in that
7 part designated "§12004." in subsection 10, paragraph
8 A by striking out all of subparagraph (1)

9 Further amend the bill in section 39, in that
10 part designated "§12004." in subsection 10, paragraph
11 A by renumbering the subparagraphs to read consecu-
12 tively.

13 Further amend the bill in section 97, 5th line
14 (page 68, line 24 in L.D.) by striking out the under-
15 lined figure "10" and inserting in its place the fol-
16 lowing: '8'

17 Further amend the bill by inserting after section
18 301 the following:

19 'Sec. 302. Savings clause. Nothing in this Act
20 shall be construed as terminating the existence of
21 any board listed in the Revised Statutes, Title 5,
22 section 12004. Except as specifically provided by
23 Title 5, sections 12002-A, 12002-B, 12003 and 12005,
24 nothing in this Act shall be construed as modifying
25 the powers, privileges, rights or liabilities of any
26 board as in effect immediately prior to the effective
27 date of this Act. Each board is declared to continue
28 in existence, and all rules, licenses, contracts,
29 resolutions and the official actions in effect or
30 outstanding immediately prior to the effective date
31 of this Act shall be unaffected by this Act.'

32 Further amend the Bill in section 302 by striking
33 out under the heading "AGRICULTURE, FOOD AND RURAL
34 RESOURCES, DEPARTMENT OF" all of that part relating
35 to "Bureau of Public Services" (page 157, lines 11

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1 to 15 in L.D.)

2 Further amend the Bill in section 302 under the
3 heading "AGRICULTURE, FOOD AND RURAL RESOURCES, DE-
4 PARTMENT OF" by striking out all of the last line
5 (page 157, line 16 in L.D.) and inserting in its
6 place the following:

7 'Total (\$1,125)'

8 Further amend the Bill in section 302 under the
9 heading "CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF" in that part
10 relating to "State Parole Board" by striking out the
11 2nd line (page 157, line 30 in L.D.) and inserting in
12 its place the following:

13 'Personal Services (2,160)'

14 Further amend the Bill in section 302 under the
15 heading "CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF" by striking out
16 all of the last line (page 157, line 33 in L.D.) and
17 inserting in its place the following:

18 'Total (\$2,375)'

19 Further amend the Bill in section 302 by striking
20 out all of the last line (page 158, line 22 in L.D.)
21 and inserting in its place the following:

22 'TOTAL ALLOCATIONS (\$6,795)'

23 Further amend the bill by renumbering section 302
24 to be section 303.

25 FISCAL NOTE

26 This amendment reduces savings to the General
27 Fund by \$2,790 compared to savings in the original
28 bill.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment makes corrections in the compensation listed for the Board of Registration of Substance Abuse Counselors and the State Board of Assessment Review.

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This amendment corrects the classification of the Animal Welfare Board from an advisory board to a policy-making board for specific or limited purposes.

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The amendment changes the rate of per diem compensation for the State Parole Board.

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
The amendment also provides for an expenses-only rate of compensation for the State Court Library Committee.

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Finally, the amendment adds a savings clause to the bill to make it clear that this bill will not affect the status of any board in existence prior to the enactment of this bill.
