HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1809, L.D. 2391, Bill, "AN ACT to Raise the Annual Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund Assessments to \$1,635,000 and to Allocate those Funds for Fiscal Year 1985."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Raise the Annual Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund Assessments to \$1,594,000 and to Allocate those Funds for Fiscal Year 1985.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 8th line (page 2, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$1,335,000" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '\$1,294,000'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 4 in the 2nd line (page 3, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "31" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '35'

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part relating to "ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION" by striking out all of the 7th to 11th lines from the end (page 3, lines 37 and 38 and page 4, lines 1 to 3 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:
