SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 1819, L.D. 2411

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to provide more 3 equity between fines levied on truck owners trans-4 porting commodities that qualify for a 10% tolerance. 5 Present law makes no distinction between the owners 6 of vehicles who purchase commodity permits and those who do not purchase the permit with respect to penal-ties for overweight. This amendment requires the pen-7 8 alty levied upon vehicle owners without commodity 9 10 permits transporting loads eligible for these permits 11 to pay a fine that includes the cost of the applica-12 ble annual permit.
