23 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
24 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
25 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

26 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-
27 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

28 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-
29 dent to tentative collective bargaining agreements
30 reached between the University of Maine and its em-
31 ployees will become due and payable immediately; and

32 Whereas, funding must be provided immediately if
33 those obligations and expenses are to be met; and
