12	'A person hired after August 31, 1984, as a law en-
13	forcement officer in the Department of Inland Fisher-
14	ies and Wildlife or in the Department of Marine Re-
15	sources shall contribute at a rate of 7.5% of earn-
16	able compensation until he has completed 25 years of
17	creditable service as a law enforcement officer in
18	those departments. After completing that service,
19	the employee shall contribute at a rate of 6.5% of
20	earnable compensation for the remainder of his em-
21	ployment in that position.'
22	Further amend the Bill in section 4 by striking
23	out all of subsection 5 and inserting in its place

Each employee of the Maine State Prison, who is an incumbent in a position de- scribed in section 1121, subsection 4, paragraph F, and who is employed as such before September 1, 1984, shall contribute at a rate of 7.5% of earnable com- pensation until he has attained eligibility for re- tirement under section 1121, subsection 4, paragraph F. After attaining eligibility for retirement, such employee shall contribute at a rate of 6.5% of earn- able compensation for the remainder of his employment in such a position.

After completing that service, the em-5 ployee shall contribute at a rate of 6.5% of earnable compensation for the remainder of his employment in б 7 such a position. 8 Further amend the Bill in section 11 in paragraph 9 H by striking out all of the first paragraph (page 8, 10 lines 14 to 24 in L.D.) and inserting in its place 11 the following: 12 'H. A member hired after August 31, 1984, as a 13 guard at a state correctional facility may retire after completion of 25 years of creditable ser-14 vice in such a position and attainment of age 55; the service retirement allowance shall be deter-15 16 17 mined in accordance with subsection 2, paragraph 18 Α. 19 Further amend the Bill in section 11 by inserting 20 at the end the following: 'I. A member hired after August 31, 1984, as a 21 22 law enforcement officer in the Department of In-23 land Fisheries and Wildlife or as a law enforcement officer in the Department of Marine Re-24 sources may retire after completion of 25 years 25 26 of creditable service in such a position and at-27 tainment of age 55; the service retirement allowance shall be determined in accordance with 28 29 subsection 2, paragraph A. 30 Any such member who has completed 25 or more 31 years of creditable service may retire at any time prior to the attainment of age 55 and re-32 33 ceive a service retirement allowance.
