HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1839, L.D. 2434,
Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the Laws Governing Certifica-
tion of Educational Personnel."

Amend the bill in section 5, last paragraph, 5th
line (page 13, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after
the words "the state board" the following: ', conduct
at least one public hearing on the pilot projects and
state board's interim report,'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
Fiscal Note the following:

'Sec. 7. Effective date. Sections 1 and 2 be-
come effective on July 1, 1988.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the present certi-
fication statutes remain in force until the new pro-
cedures take effect on July 1, 1988 and directs the
Joint Standing Committee on Education to hold a pub-
lic hearing prior to its April 1, 1987, requirement
to submit recommendations for changes to the new
Teacher Certification Act.
