HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 912, L.D. 2451,
Bill, "AN ACT Making Appropriations and Allocations
for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing
Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper
Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years
Ending June 30, 1984, and June 30, 1985."

Amend the bill by striking out all of Part W.

Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts
to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

Enactment of this amendment would result in a
loss of \$1.2 million in revenue to the General Fund
for fiscal year 1985.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment reinstates the discount on liquor
sold to licensees.
