SENATE AMENDMENT " D" to S.P. 913, L.D. 2452,

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Bill, "AN ACT to Replace the Regional Refuse Disposal

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District Enabling Act."

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Amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "§1705." by inserting after subsection 13 the following:

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'14. Solid waste facility. "Solid waste facility" means an incinerator facility, a landfill facility or a transfer facility.'

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Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "§1705." by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

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Further amend the bill in section 2, in that part designated "§1724." in subsection 1, in the 10th to 14th lines (page 13, lines 11 to 15 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "unless an alternative method of apportioning votes is approved by a majority vote of the municipal officers representing each member of the disposal district prior to or at the time of formation" and inserting in their place the underlined words: 'but in no case may the votes of the host municipality be less than 20% of the total district votes'
