8 STATEMENT OF FACT
This amendment revises the salary increase for members of the Judiciary and allows them an 8% salary increase, effective August 1, 1984. It also deletes the minimum retirement benefit of 60% of Average Final Compensation. State employees do not have a minimum benefit and it is not needed since the salaries are not increasing as much as originally recommended.
This amendment also deletes any changes in the salaries of Constitutional Officers and retains these salaries at \$30,000; except for the salary of the Attorney General, which will remain at its current level of \$44,431.
