| 16 | of implements and devices in Washington County waters |
| 17 | was inadvertently omitted from the marine resources |
| 18 | law when the law on inland waters was recodified as |
| 19 | it deals with tidal waters; and |
| 20 | Whereas, this law is still necessary and its in- |
| 21 | advertent repeal would create confusion concerning |
| 22 | the use of these implements and devices in Washington |
| 23 | County waters; and |
| 24 | Whereas, this legislation is necessary as emer- |
| 25 | gency legislation to avoid that confusion; and |
| 26 | Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, |
| 27 | these facts create an emergency within the meaning of |
| 28 | the Constitution of Maine and require the following |
| 29 | legislation as immediately necessary for the preser- |
