'Sec. 4. Nonlapsing account effective July 1,  
1986. There is created a nonlapsing account into  
which shall be paid \$27,000,000 a year, as appropri-  
ated by future sessions of the Legislature, to be ex-  
pended for enhancement of teachers compensation and  
such additional moneys as the Legislature may appro-  
priate to cover the costs of implementing this Act  
which are not included in the Commissioner of Educa-  
tional and Cultural Services' recommended funding  
level for education. The mechanism for expending  
these funds shall be recommended by the committee  
created to monitor the implementation of this Act and  
as approved by the Legislature.'
