HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1899, L.D. 2495,
8 Bill, "AN ACT to Revise Certain Portions of the Tax
9 Laws Relative to Income Tax Conformity, Sales Taxes,
10 Real Estate Transfer Taxes and Cigarette Taxes and to
11 Increase Revenue Collections."

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Amend the bill in PART A by striking out all of
section 14 (page 7, lines 22 to 24 in L.D.) and in-
serting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 14. Effective date. Section 9 of this Act
shall take effect on October 1, 1985, provided that
the federal excise tax reduction set out in the
United States Internal Revenue Code, section 5701 (C)
as enacted by Section 283 of the United States Tax
Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act of 1982, Public
Law 97-248, is implemented on or before that date.
If the reduction of federal excise tax is not so im-
plemented on or before that date, section 9 shall not
take effect and shall be repealed. All other sec-
tions shall be effective December 15, 1984.'

2 This amendment makes the 8¢ cigarette tax in-
3 crease contingent upon a reduction of the federal
4 cigarette tax which is scheduled to take place Octo-
