Ordered, that the Joint Standing Committee on Ed-
ucation assess the impact of the education reform law
and rules promulgated pursuant to that law on educa-
tion funding formula and school budgets and the role
of the State in financing education; and be it fur-
ther

Ordered, that the Legislature encourages and
invites the participation and advice of the superin-
tendents of schools, elected town councillors and
managers, school board and school committee members
and teachers; and be it further

Ordered, that the Legislative Council, before im-
plementing this study and determining an appropriate
level of funding, shall first ensure that this direc-
tive can be accomplished within the limits of availa-
ble resources, that it is combined with other
initiatives similar in scope to avoid duplication and
that its purpose is within the best interests of the
State; and be it further
