18 Appoint Deputy Treasurers and

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 30 MRSA §2255, sub-§4 is amended to read:

24 4. Absence. If the clerk, treasurer or tax
25 collector fails to do so, the municipal officers may
26 appoint a deputy ~~clerk~~ to act during his absence.

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 The purpose of this bill is to give municipal of-
29 ficers the authority to appoint a deputy during the
30 treasurer's or tax collector's absence. Municipal of-

1 ficers presently have the authority to appoint a dep-
2 uty if the clerk fails to do so in his or her ab-
3 sence. This bill provides municipal officers with the
4 same authority to appoint a deputy treasurer or depu-
5 ty tax collector.

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
