1 the intent to deprive the store or establishment of 2 the merchandise shall be liable to the store or es-3 tablishment for the damages set forth in this sec-4 tion. An action for recovery of damages pursuant to this section may be brought as a small claims action 5 6 if the total damages do not exceed the jurisdictional limit for small claims actions. The District Court shall have jurisdiction over actions brought pursuant 7 8 to this section. The provisions of this section are 9 in addition to any other civil remedies of the retail 10 11 establishment or store.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

13 The purpose of this bill is to provide merchants 14 with a civil recovery remedy against shoplifters and 15 to provide a deterrent against shoplifting.
