17 AN ACT to Amend the Laws Concerning Fire  
18 Prevention and Protection.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2446, first ¶ is amended to  
23 read:

24 No heating, cooking or refrigerating appliances  
25 consuming flammable liquids, flammable liquid com-  
26 pounds with flash point of 200° Fahrenheit or under,  
27 liquefied petroleum gases, artificial, natural or  
28 manufactured gases shall may be sold or offered for  
29 sale in this State unless such appliances have the  
30 approved listing of the Underwriters' Laboratories,  
31 Inc., the American Gas Association Testing Laborate-  
32 ries or the Department of Industrial Cooperation at  
33 the University of Maine any nationally recognized  
34 laboratory that meets the standards of the State Fire  
35 Marshal. The expense of obtaining such approval shall  
36 be paid by the manufacturers, distributors or  
37 marketers of such appliances.
