17 AN ACT to Equalize Trapping Rights in  
18 Unorganized Territory.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7377, sub-§2, ¶D, as enacted by PL 1979,  
23 c. 420, §1, is repealed.

24 STATEMENT OF FACT

25 Currently, resident owners of property in or-  
26 ganized townships may trap on that property without a  
27 license. Property owners in unorganized territories  
28 must have a license to trap on their property.

29 This bill eliminates this license requirement for  
30 residents of unorganized territories.

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
