AN ACT to Equalize Trapping Rights in Unorganized Territory.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<pre>12 MRSA §7377, sub-§2, ¶D, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is repealed.</pre>
STATEMENT OF FACT
Currently, resident owners of property in organized townships may trap on that property without a license. Property owners in unorganized territories must have a license to trap on their property.
This bill eliminates this license requirement for residents of unorganized territories.
