17 AN ACT to Amend the Motor Vehicle Inspection
18 Law.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §2518, sub-§1, as repealed and
23 replaced by PL 1983, c. 816, Pt. A, §30, is amended
24 to read:

25 1. Disposition of stickers. All inspection
26 stickers and materials issued to inspection stations
27 by the Chief of the State Police shall remain the
28 property of the State. Each official inspection station
29 shall stock a sufficient number of stickers to
30 meet their demands at all times. These shall be furnished
31 by the Chief of the State Police at 50¢ each.
32 The stickers shall be made of such material and quality
33 of adhesive as prescribed by the Chief of the
34 State Police. At the end of the calendar year, or if
35 the station license is suspended, any unused or expired
36 stickers shall, within 20 working days, be re-

1 turned to the Chief of the State Police and the pur-
2 chase price refunded or exchanged for current year
3 stickers, except that refunds or exchanges shall not
4 be made for other than full sheets of unused stick-
5 ers-

6 Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §2525, as amended by PL 1983, c.
7 370, §15, is repealed and the following enacted in
8 its place:

9 §2525. Return or refund of unused stickers

10 At the end of the calendar year, or upon suspen-
11 sion, revocation or termination of an inspection li-
12 cence, any unused or expired stickers shall, within
13 20 working days, be returned to the Chief of the
14 State Police and the purchase price refunded or ex-
15 changed for current year stickers, except that re-
16 fundings or exchanges shall not be made for other than
17 full sheets of unused stickers. Upon suspension,
18 revocation or termination of an inspection license,
19 the inspection station owner or manager shall return
20 all inspection materials to the Chief of the State
21 Police who shall issue a receipt for the returned ma-
22 terials.

23 STATEMENT OF FACT

24 This bill clarifies the law regarding refunds to
25 inspection stations for unused inspection stickers
26 for motor vehicles. Presently, the laws regarding
27 such refunds are contained in 2 separate sections.
28 This bill combines these 2 sections and clarifies the
29 language of the statute.

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
