1 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6256 is enacted to read:

§6256. Distribution of Atlantic salmon smolt

The commission shall prepare and annually carry out a plan for the distribution of Atlantic salmon smolt which provides that each river identified in section 6255 shall receive at least 1% of all Atlantic salmon smolt distributed in each year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to improve the enforcement provisions for salmon fishing on the most attractive segments of the state's salmon rivers. The bill encourages the development of a catch and release fishery for Atlantic salmon which is in the best interests of an increasing salmon population. The bill also ensures that each of the salmon rivers receive some salmon smolt to offset the growing fishing pressure along these rivers. The bill will not significantly affect the quantity of smolt available for the commission's ongoing efforts on the major salmon rivers.
