1 A. A person who has voted votes by absentee bal-2 lot but who is present in the municipality and 3 able to vote at the proper voting place on elec-4 tion day and fails to vote in person is quilty of 5 a Class E erime, unless that person was engaged in registering voters for that election on elec-tion day at the office of the registrar or the board of registration working during the entire 6 7 8 9 time the polls in his municipality were open and, 10 as a result, was unable to get to his voting 11 place while the polls were open;

12B. A municipal clerk who, when a person has13voted by absentee ballot in the clerk's effice14presence under section 753, subsection 7, signs15his name to an affidavit on the absentee ballot16return envelope when the affidavit is not proper-17ly completed; or'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

19 This amendment adds as a reason for challenging a 20 voter or ballot that the person voted using the name 21 of another person. This is a class D crime.

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 32, L.D. 33 This amendment removes the restrictions placed on candidates concerning serving as witnesses. Under this amendment, a candidate who is a notary or other official may serve as a single witness. If a candidate is not a notary or other official, he may serve as one of 2 witnesses. This is treating the candidate the same as anyone else. 8
