21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 5 MRSA §1001, sub-§25 is amended to read:

24 25. Teacher. "Teacher" ~~shall mean~~ means any
25 teacher, principal, supervisor, school nurse, school
26 dietitian, school secretary, ~~or~~ superintendent,
27 school psychologist, physical therapist, occupational
28 therapist or any other school employee employed in
29 any public school, including teachers in unorganized
30 territory.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to add all other
3 school employees to the definition of teacher and
4 provides for equitable treatment for all school em-
5 ployees in the retirement system.

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
