7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{A} " to H.P. 38, L.D. 40, 8 Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Bustin's 9 Island Village Corporation."

10 Amend the bill by inserting before the Emergency 11 clause the following:

12 'Sec. 4. Referendum; acceptance of amendments. 13 These amendments to the charter of Bustin's Island may be accepted within 2 years from the date of the 14 15 Act being approved by the Governor. Their rejection during that period shall not prevent their acceptance 16 17 at a later time during that period, but any meeting 18 to vote on these amendments shall take place within 19 the months of July and August.

This Act shall be submitted to the legal voters of 20 the corporation at a regular or special meeting of the corporation, provided that the warrant calling 21 22 23 the meeting contains an appropriate article for that 24 purpose. The meeting shall be called and conducted 25 according to the law governing meetings of the corpo-26 ration, except voting on the article relating to this 27 Act shall be accomplished by written ballot and vot-28 ing by proxy shall not be allowed on this article, 29 but voting by absentee ballot in the form and manner 30 prescribed by law for municipal elections shall be 31 allowed.

32 The overseers shall prepare ballots upon which shall 33 be the question: "Do you favor amending the Bustin's 34 Island Corporation charter, as proposed by the Legis-35 lature, to:

Relieve Freeport from having to perform mu nicipal services for the corporation; and

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1 2	2. Make the following changes with respect to the corporation:
3	A. Return to it 60% of the real estate and
4	personal property taxes collected by the
5	town;
6	B. Authorize it to borrow money to fund mu-
7	nicipal services; and
8 9	C. Remove the limits on the taxes it may assess and the indebtedness it may incur?"
10	If this Act is accepted by a majority of the legal
11	voters voting at such a meeting in person or by ab-
12	sentee ballot, and the total number of votes cast
13	equaled or exceeded 50% of the total number of votes
14	cast in the last regular election of overseers, then
15	this Act shall take effect.
16	The result of the vote taken at the meeting shall be
17	declared in open meeting by the overseers and a cer-
18	tificate of the result of the meeting shall be filed
19	by the clerk with the Secretary of State.'
20	Further amend the bill by striking out the Emer-
21	gency clause and inserting in its place the follow-
22	ing:
23	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
24	in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
25	proved by the Governor so far as to authorize the
26	calling of a meeting of the village corporation for
27	the purpose of voting upon the acceptance of these
28	charter amendments. Whenever these amendments shall
29	be accepted by a majority of the voters of the corpo-
30	ration at a legal meeting called for that purpose,
31	then the same shall take and have complete effect in
32	all their parts.'

2 3 4	This amendment requires the acceptance of the charter amendments by the village corporation in or- der for the Act to take effect.
