COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "^A" to H.P. 45, L.D. 51,
Bill, "AN ACT Regarding Notice of Municipal Shellfish
Conservation Programs."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of
the first line after the enacting clause (page 1,
line 22 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill in subsection 3 in the 8th
line from the end (page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by strik-
ing out the underlined word "statewide"

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6676 is enacted to read:
§6676. Summary of municipal ordinances

The department shall prepare a summary descrip-
tion of all municipal shellfish ordinances which
shall include, but not be limited to, a listing for
each municipality of the license application period,
fee structure, number of licenses available to resi-
dents and nonresidents. The department shall update
and publish the summary every 6 months in a trade or
industry journal which the commissioner considers to
be effective in reaching the persons affected.'
