The fee for 4 nonresident license shall be not more than 10 times 5 the fee for a resident license, provided that in 6 case may the fee for a nonresident license exceed 7 \$150. Notice of the number and the procedure for application shall be published in a trade or 8 industry 9 publication, or in a newspaper or combination of 10 newspapers with general statewide circulation, the municipal officers consider effective in reaching 11 persons affected, not less than 10 days prior to the 12 13 period of issuance and shall be posted in the munici-14 pal offices until the period concludes. Subsequent 15 to that period, the municipality shall make any resi-16 dent or nonresident licenses not granted during the 17 period available to residents or nonresidents.

The requirement that notice of the number and procedure for applying for nonresident shellfish licenses be published in a trade or industry publication has proven difficult to comply with. There are few such publications and they require notices for printing months in advance. The purpose of this bill is to give the municipal officers the alternative to publish the notice in a newspaper or combination of newspapers to achieve statewide circulation.
