- 7. Penalty. Possession of lobsters in violation of this section shall be a Class D crime, except that the court shall impose a fine of \$25 for each violation and, in addition, a fine of \$10 for each lobster involved, up to and including the first 5, and a fine \$30 for each lobster in excess of 5, or, if the number of lobsters cannot be determined, a fine not more than \$1,000. If the total number lobsters in violation of this section are equal to or greater than 20% of the total of all lobsters in his possession at the time of the offense, then the commissioner shall suspend the license for a period of one year for the first offense, 2 years for the 2nd offense and 3 years for the 3rd offense.

- 2. Purchases: liberation. The commissioner may authorize the expenditure of the money in the Lobster Fund for the purpose of purchasing seed lobsters from Maine lobster pound owners and female lobsters from wholesale seafood license holders and licensed lobster fishermen. The commissioner shall establish the purchase price for seed and female lobsters after consultation with the industry. The commissioner shall give priority to purchasing seed lobsters.

2 The lobster fund is currently used for purchasing 3 seed lobsters to be liberated by the Department of Marine Resources also female nonegg bearing lobsters 4 5 are purchased by the Department of Marine Resources 6 all of which are V-notched then released, a portion 7 of these lobsters may be tagged to determine the migratory habits of these lobsters. This bill broadens 8 the authority of the commissioner to permit the use 9 10 of a portion of the fund for other lobster studies 11 aimed at conserving the resource.
