18 Resolve, Reimbursing Certain Municipalities  
19 on Account of Taxes Lost Due to Lands  
20 being Classified under the Tree  
21 Growth Tax Law.

23 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves  
24 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90  
25 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;  
26 and

27 Whereas, certain municipalities have been reim-  
28 bursed 75% of the tax loss pursuant to the Revised  
29 Statutes, Title 36, section 578, and there remains  
30 moneys due these municipalities; and

31 Whereas, certain municipalities currently need  
32 the remaining reimbursement funds due to the taxes  
33 lost; and

34 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,  
35 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following  
2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-  
3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
4 therefore, be it

5 Reimbursements to be paid to certain  
6 municipalites. Resolved: That the following desig-  
7 nated municipalities be reimbursed for the sums indi-  
8 cated totaling \$111,413.91 under the Maine Tree  
9 Growth Tax Law pursuant to the Revised Statutes, Ti-  
10 tle 36, section 578, subsection 1:
