Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of  
the first line after the enacting clause (page 1,  
line 21 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the bill in subsection 5 in the 6th  
line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the  
underlined words "apply again for" and inserting in  
their place the underlined word 'obtain'

Further amended the bill in subsection 5 in the  
6th line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out  
the underlined figure "3" and inserting in its place  
the underlined figure '2'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end  
before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take ef-  
fect January 1, 1986.'
