17 AN ACT Concerning Eligibility to Hunt Moose.

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
20 follows:

21 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1981,
22 c. 118, §2, is amended to read:

23 5. Eligibility. Any Except as provided in this
24 subsection, any Maine resident, nonresident or alien
25 who is eligible to obtain a Maine hunting license is
26 eligible to apply for a moose hunting permit. No
27 person who has obtained a moose hunting permit may
28 apply again for another permit until 3 years have
29 elapsed since the issuance of the last permit. This
30 limitation does not apply to subpermittees.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires any person who has obtained a moose hunting permit to wait 3 years before becoming eligible to apply for another permit. This limitation does not apply to subpermittees.

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
