## STATEMENT OF FACT

 This bill provides for purchases of small quantities of fuel to be used exclusively for home heating fuel. The intent is to prevent hardship on people whose circumstances require the purchase of that fuel at the pump. The present limit of 275 gallons exceeds the practical need of the case cited and invites evasion of highway use taxes that the suppliers law controls. The proposed limit of 55 gallons is more appropriate for the cited purpose and will largely reduce any opportunity for evasion. It should be noted that anyone may purchase larger quantities at the pump and claim a refund.
