17 AN ACT to Measure Mileage Payments to Jurors.

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
20 follows:

21 14 MRSA §1215, as amended by PL 1981, c. 490, §1,  
22 is further amended to read:

23 §1215. Mileage and compensation of jurors

24 A juror shall be paid mileage at the rate of ~~15¢~~  
25 22¢ per mile for his travel expenses from his resi-  
26 dence to the place of holding court and return and  
27 shall be compensated at the rate of \$20 for each day  
28 of required attendance at sessions of the court.

The purpose of this bill is to increase the mileage payment to jurors from 15¢ a mile to 22¢ a mile, which is the rate currently paid to witnesses.
