20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §6440, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1977, c.
23 661, §5, is amended to read:

24 1. Summer. During the period 1/2 hour after
25 sunset from 5 p.m. eastern daylight saving time until
26 1/2 hour before sunrise from June 1st to October 31st
27 August 31st, both days inclusive; and

The taking of lobsters during the summer months is currently restricted to 1/2 hour after sunset until 1/2 hour before sunrise. To conserve the lobster resource, it is beneficial to close the fishing from 5 p.m. during weekdays, which will also conserve the enforcement and operating expenses for the industry.
