Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting 11 12 clause the following: 13 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-14 lature do not become effective until 90 days after 15 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 16 Whereas, Massachusetts regulation requires that all overweight permitted loads in excess of 80,000 17 18 pounds be registered for the gross weight allowed by 19 the overweight permit; and 20 Whereas, Maine companies have been fined large 21 amounts of money and in some cases forced to register 22 in Massachusetts; and 23 Whereas, this legislation allows for the issuance a special commercial weight registration certifi-24 of 25 cate that will alleviate the problem caused by the 26 Massachusetts regulation; and 27 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 28 the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-29 30 31 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 32 therefore,' 33 Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following: 34

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
