STATEMENT OF FACT

4 The purpose of this bill is to amend the law re-5 lating to absentee voting by residents of coastal is-6 lands. It permits the clerk on the mainland where the 7 coastal island resident votes to direct the island 8 warden by telephone to mark the island check list to 9 indicate the vote.

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
