COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "^A" to H.P. 84, L.D. 104,
Bill, "AN ACT to Require a Trespass Reminder on Hunt-
ing and Fishing Licenses."

Amend the bill in subsection 8 in the 3rd, 4th
and 5th lines (page 1, lines 25 to 27 in L.D.) by
striking out the following: "Notice: This license
does not give the holder the right to trespass. Re-
member to request permission of the landowner." and
inserting in its place the following: "Notice: This
license does not give the holder the right to enter
upon private property against the wishes of the prop-
erty owner. Please seek landowner permission before
hunting or fishing on someone else's land."

This amendment changes the wording of the notice
to be placed on the license. The change is to insure
that the license does not give the impression that it
is a legal requirement that permission must be ob-
tained before someone may hunt.
